



DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Good evening.

Thank you for joining us at New Village Arts for tonight's production of *The 39 Steps*. Tonight, dozens of characters will travel across the UK, by plane, by train, by automobile—but only four actors will set foot on the stage. Patrick Barlow's delightful comic adaptation of this early Hitchcock classic (itself based on the novel by John Buchan) trades the suspense of the film for theatrical suspense—how on earth will these four actors do it?

My father showed me some iconic Hitchcock films growing up: North by Northwest, Rear Window, Psycho, Vertigo. Later, I studied film in school and gained a greater appreciation for Hitchcock's mastery of the art of suspense, and even moreso, for how effortlessly he blends humor into his stories. Many of Hitchcock's films have a delightfully wry, dark sense of humor—and if you've watched Alfred Hitchcock Presents, you'll recall his monologues were often full of memorably-understated jokes. No wonder, then, that this delightful adaptation leans into comedy, even as the stakes remain high.

In *The 39 Steps*, as with so many Hitchcock films, we follow a protagonist who finds himself alienated from his world—a world that has lost its luster, where he feels increasingly isolated. A world that he views through cynical eyes. As he becomes entwined in the mysteries and intrigue of the plot, he finds a renewed sense of passion and excitement for his life—and more importantly, a sense of compassion for others.

What I love about this show is that among the cacophony of characters and clowns, we see the call for the creation of a kinder, gentler world. How we get there, of course, is a comedy of errors. And that's the fun of it.

So please, do not adjust your television sets—sit back and enjoy *The 39 Steps*.

KATE ROSE REYNOLDS (she/her), Intimacy Coordinator






Cultivating Dreams in Unlikely Places



The Dea Hurston Fellowship was created to address the lack of paid opportunities for women, BIPOC, and other underserved theater administrators, artists, and students in our region.

As a young girl, Dea was denied access to music lessons and other artistic ventures due to the prevailing racist attitudes, politics, and laws. THE DEA HURSTON FELLOWSHIP (DHF) ADDRESSES THREE MAIN CATEGORIES:

HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS

The high school program focuses on accessibility to the arts. The DHF provides free tickets to shows, education from industry professionals, and mentorship opportunities. The DHF will give priority to female and female presenting students from lower-income/ higher-diversity schools.

BIPOC AND WOMEN COLLEGE STUDENTS

The college program focuses on creating professional opportunities for BIPOC, women, and other underserved theatre artists currently in college. DHF covers stipends for these emerging artists to work in local professional theatres, as well as mentorship from industry professionals.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE FOR BIPOC ARTISTS AND OTHER UNDERREPRESENTED PEOPLE

The professional level supports the hiring of BIPOC artists in professional theatres in San Diego County, at NVA and beyond. The DHF is changing the face of San Diego theatre by creating new and exciting opportunities where the arts community has previously lacked. The DHF creates a safe space for individuals to hone their skills and provides the support needed to be successful.
