

OVERALL

NVA was an itinerant theatre company in 2021-2022, producing shows at multiple locations around San Diego County while our home facility was under construction.









EDUCATION & OUTREACH

NVA continued our popular **online** programs like the **NVA Film Club** and produced two full productions at The Flower Fields with our groundbreaking Mainstage Players program for teens and young adults with neurodiversity: **THE MECHANICALS** and **STELLALUNA**.



NEW PLAY FESTIVAL

NVA presented **10 original, world premiere play readings** and hosted two panel discussions, matched with the perfect craft beers from

Pure Project Brewing.













In addition to The Mainstage Players productions, NVA produced two full musicals: BEEHIVE and LEONARD BERNSTEIN'S NEW YORK, both playing to full houses and receiving rave reviews. NVA also hosted a complete music series with local bands including We The Commas, Electric Waste Band, and Sabrosas Latin Orchestra, filling The Flower Fields with music and dancing.









RENOVATIONS FUNDRAISING





TOTAL RAISED TO-DATE: \$898,367

During the COVID pandemic shutdown, NVA laid the groundwork for a major capital fundraising campaign for building renovations. Leadership gifts from the Sahm Family Foundation and the Nordson Corporation Foundation led the way. This year, major gifts from the Prebys Foundation, the County of San Diego, K.A. Keller, Jack & Valerie Cumming, and the trusts of the White, Ginn, and Missett families brought us closer to our goal.

EXPENSES

The majority of our expenses go directly into creating the award-winning, creative productions that NVA has become known for as well as for the staff supporting those productions. We pride ourselves on working with some of the greatest actors, designers, technicians, and creative minds in San Diego and North County, and for our inclusive hiring practices that ensure all members of our community are represented in all areas of our work. NVA was founded on the principle that all artists should be fairly compensated for their contributions, and we are proud to highlight their work on our stage and behind the scenes.
