NVA opened as the Dea Hurston New Village Arts Center in January of 2023 with an unforgettable production of Jez Butterworth's THE FERRYMAN directed by Executive Artistic Director Kristianne Kurner. The official groundbreaking ceremony occurred on July 7, 2022; and we hosted the Grand Opening Celebration on April 29, 2023, creating a cultural gathering space for our community that would welcome over 30,000 people annually.









REVENUE

CONTRIBUTED REVENUE: \$938,283




FINANCIALS
